SUBJECT: Non-Compliance with EHS approval- Certificate of Conformity (COC)

All the contractors/consultants/PMTs are hereby advised to confirm their COC status before submitting any MCC/BCC application to EHS. All the MCC/BCC submissions should clearly verify a valid COC in the EHS check list as required part of the submission process. The submission if not confirm the COC status of the project; will not be entertained for final inspections.

Please refer to the applicability of COC matrix (EHS-CSP-04 - http link: http://www.ehss.ae/forms/ehs-psp-04clientprocedureforehs-nocformodifications&fit-outworksrev.07,28.12.pdf) which is available on our website for your easy reference & compliance. Kindly make sure that applicability matrix is cross-checked and necessary guidance is obtained from EHS if required, prior to commencing the work.

Any deviation from the above mentioned process will lead to take appropriate action in order to fulfill the regulatory requirements.

All the Dubai World Business Units are required to communicate the same to their clients / consultants / PMT's / contractors for necessary compliance.
